How Billerica Got It's Name

One of the things that is uniquely different about Billerica is its name. There is a "Concord" in more that half the states in our country and in many other places aroud the world but there is only one "Billerica" in the entire world.

When English settlers first began to inhabit this area it was know as Shawshin. The territory was grated to Cambridge in 1641 on the condition they would make it a village having at least ten families within ten years. When enough families had moved here to establish a town, they wanted to give the town a name that reminded them of their English home. Their new home was beautiful and special and the people wanted a name that would reflect that. Some of the settlers were from an area near Billericay, England which was a picturesque little country town with a unique name. It was the only town named "Billericay" that they knew of, so on May 29, 1655, "Billerica" was born.

Many People find the name hard to pronounce and even harder to spell. The petition from the General Court in 1655 that allowed the establishment of the town spelled it "Billirikeyca". When he visited here in 1789, George Washington spelled it "Bellarika" in his journal. However, those of us who are from here are proud of the name, and of the town. Billerica has many fine traits and qualities that add to its distinctiveness to make it special but its name makes it truly unique.




